The Duluth Entertainment Convention Center (DECC) is a multi-purpose facility located on the waterfront of Lake Superior in Duluth, Minn. The DECC is a multifaceted facility, with two ice arenas and an auditorium that hosts concerts, Broadway plays, operas, dance recitals and other activities.

Included in the DECC are a convention center with two ballrooms, 30 meeting rooms and more than 100,000 square feet of exhibit space to host conventions, trade shows, and community events. They use the solution in floor scrubbers, spray bottles and the Tennant 1610 Carpet Machine with ReadySpace® technology.
