



## S9 Sweeper Daily Operator Checklist Read and understand the Operator's Manual

Before Operation:
□ Confirm the battery is fully charged.
<ul> <li>Connect the battery charger AC cable and plug in the charger, if required.</li> </ul>
☐ Move the dust filter cleaning handle back and forth a few times to clean the filter.
☐ Lift the hopper locking lever, remove and empty the hopper.
☐ Remove any wire, string, or twine that may have become wrapped around the side brushes.
☐ Remove any wire, string, or twine that may have become wrapped around the main brushes.
□ Slide the hopper into the machine until the locking lever engages.
□ Adjust the rear main brush height, if required.
☐ Adjust the handle height, if required.
☐ Turn on the key switch.
☐ Lower the side brushes, if they will be used.
□ Choose the correct operational setting for conditions.
<ul> <li>From left to right, the first button turns on the main brushes, the side brushes and the</li> </ul>
vacuum fan.
<ul> <li>The second button turns on only the main brushes and the side brushes.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>The third button turns on only the main brushes and the vacuum fan.</li> </ul>
☐ Control propelling speed, as needed for conditions.
After Operation
After Operation:
<ul><li>☐ Turn off the key switch.</li><li>☐ If the side brushes were used, raise them.</li></ul>
<ul> <li>☐ Move the dust filter cleaning handle back and forth a few times to clean the filter.</li> </ul>
☐ Lift the hopper locking lever, remove and empty the hopper.
☐ Inspect the dust filter.
<ul> <li>If the filter needs to be removed for cleaning or replacement, move the two retaining</li> </ul>
levers to the unlocked position, lower and remove the filter from the retaining
<ul> <li>Clean and reinstall the filter.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>The decal indicates the correct direction for the filter installation. (Arrow Pointing Up)</li> </ul>
☐ Slide the hopper into the machine and the locking lever will automatically engage.
☐ Connect the battery charger AC cable and plug in the charger.
