



S9 Sweeper Daily Operator Checklist

Read and understand the Operator's Manual



Before Operation:

- ☐ Confirm the battery is fully charged.
 - Connect the battery charger AC cable and plug in the charger, if required.
- ☐ Move the dust filter cleaning handle back and forth a few times to clean the filter.
- ☐ Lift the hopper locking lever, remove and empty the hopper.
- ☐ Remove any wire, string, or twine that may have become wrapped around the side brushes.
- ☐ Remove any wire, string, or twine that may have become wrapped around the main brushes.
- ☐ Slide the hopper into the machine until the locking lever engages.
- ☐ Adjust the rear main brush height, if required.
- ☐ Adjust the handle height, if required.
- ☐ Turn on the key switch.
- ☐ Lower the side brushes, if they will be used.
- ☐ Choose the correct operational setting for conditions.
 - From left to right, the first button turns on the main brushes, the side brushes and the vacuum fan.
 - The second button turns on only the main brushes and the side brushes.
 - The third button turns on only the main brushes and the vacuum fan.
- ☐ Control propelling speed, as needed for conditions.

After Operation:

- ☐ Turn off the key switch.
- ☐ If the side brushes were used, raise them.
- ☐ Move the dust filter cleaning handle back and forth a few times to clean the filter.
- ☐ Lift the hopper locking lever, remove and empty the hopper.
- ☐ Inspect the dust filter.
 - If the filter needs to be removed for cleaning or replacement, move the two retaining levers to the unlocked position, lower and remove the filter from the retainer.
 - Clean and reinstall the filter.
 - The decal indicates the correct direction for the filter installation. (Arrow Pointing Up)
- ☐ Slide the hopper into the machine and the locking lever will automatically engage.
- ☐ Connect the battery charger AC cable and plug in the charger.
